Did You Know...

Inventor Robert Propst is known as the "Father of the Cubicle." While working at Herman Miller Inc. (office furniture manufacture) in the late 1960's, Propst studied office space design and



workflow. He came up with a concept known as the Action Office, which would streamline the workspace and do away with the desk bullpens that were the norm. While cubicles turned out to be very successful commercially, Propst later regretted how his original vision devolved into the "cube farms" of today.

According to the CIA's World Fact Book, there are over 1.2 million miles of natural gas pipelines and nearly 150,000 miles of petroleum pipelines in the United States.
